

COL Victor C. Wegenhoft, as COSSAR Registrar-Historian, prepared the concise historical document about COSSAR from its beginnings in 1896 to its Centennial Year of 1996 entitled *The First Century: A History*. It included three appendices listing the state presidents, national officers and awards and medals.

David L. Van Wormer, Membership Secretary/Registrar for COSSAR in 2002, added to the work of Compatriot Wegenhoft and entitled his efforts as *The First Hundred Years And Beyond*. Compatriot Van Wormer added annual updates to Compatriot Wegenhoft's three appendices and added other historical lists among which was an annual update of the chapter officers and a Master Register of the new COSSAR members from its origination. He continued these annual updates at least through 2006.

LTC Edmund P. Karr, Jr., converted *The First Century: A History* to a PDF file. The three appendices and the historical lists added by Compatriot Van Wormer were converted to Word and Excel files that can be updated annually and posted to the COSSAR website as PDF files. This will ease the making and sharing of annual updates to keep the membership informed of the emerging history of COSSAR.
